






Who You Are-

- Perform millwrighting work on-site to meet project deadlines and budgets, and to ensure compliance with job specifications and Company standards,
- Assemble bucket elevators and conveyors on site
- Work with mobile cranes to install equipment

- Assemble and install access walkways in grain system
- Assemble unloading augers, conveyors as required
- Assist with repairs and maintenance during peak system
